**General function:** Under the supervision of the Adventure Program Director, in accordance with the policies of the YMCA, this person will facilitate activities within the high and low ropes program areas (tower, low ropes, and teambuilding) in order to provide a high quality and safe program for campers and staff during summer camp.

**Qualifications:**

1. At least 18 years old.
2. Holds or has evidence of having held experience or training in a similar adventure course.
3. Participate in specific on sight training of Camp Wood YMCA's Alpine Tower.
4. Current American Red Cross First Aid, CPR, or equivalent certification.
5. Furnish Camp Wood YMCA with a current physical examination form signed by a licensed physician, showing you to be in good health and free of contagious diseases. Camp Wood will furnish physical form.
6. Lifeguard Trained a plus.
7. Loves to work with children and be ready for challenging, yet rewarding work.

**Specific Responsibilities:**

1. Assist in the development of the program for each adventure activity, whether tower or group initiatives.
2. Maintains complete and current files on all adventure programs and daily operations.
3. Directs and implements all camp policies (administration, health, safety regulations, emergency procedures, risk management, etc.)
4. Provides appropriate coordination and cooperation to all staff related to the adventure program on a day to day basis.
5. Assures compliance with all the health and safety standards established by Camp Wood YMCA.
6. Maintains a clean and organized program area and its equipment.
7. Identifies and reports maintenance needs of the adventure area and equipment to the Adventure Program Director.
8. Maintains a complete inventory on adventure program equipment.
9. Develops and implements actions to increase the learning and satisfactory experience of campers and staff.
10. Cooperates with the entire staff in working together for the welfare of campers and the camp.
